The individual needs to be technically proficient in several areas of acoustics:

- Proficient in understanding project requirements – liaison with stakeholders, coordinating and carrying out site work in line with appropriate policies and procedures, managing clients deadlines and requirements.
- Significant experience of noise monitoring.
- Ideally experience in building acoustic design and in building acoustic testing (although not essential).
- Experience of noise modelling using software such as SoundPlan, Insul, Odeon etc.
- Experience of preparing proposals and tenders, reviewing costings.
- Ideally some experience of peer reviewing technical reports.



Applicants with skills and experience in business development and commercial management would be welcomed but this is not essential.

- Completing acoustic assessments and projects from start to completion.
- Site visits and meetings with clients and stakeholders.
