Overview of Role:

Your Day-to-Day:

As the role sits within the acoustics team the main tasks will centre around the undertaking and support of building acoustics assessments/reviews and monitoring surveys across the UK in accordance with appropriate Standards and Guidance. From time to time the role may also necessitate the use of 3-dimensional modelling using proprietary acoustic modelling software packages, so a knowledge of one or more of BASTION, ODEON, INSUL, CATT and the generalities of modelling would be beneficial.

In addition, support would be provided to the environmental part of the acoustics team undertaking environmental noise (and vibration) assessments supporting both EIA's and planning applications to appropriate Standards and Guidance. This typically necessitates the undertaking of detailed 3-dimensional modelling and as such a knowledge of one or more of SoundPLAN, IMMI or NoiseMAP 5.0 would be beneficial, along with an understanding of the generalities of 3D modelling techniques and issues.

What You have to Offer:

- A BSc degree (or similar) with a science, mathematics, environmental or acoustic focus/content;
- High level of proficiency in using the Microsoft Office suite, particularly Word and Excel;
- Knowledge and Experience of 3-dimensional modelling of noise;
- Highly motivated and committed;
