THE ROLE

As part of PureGym's accelerated growth of its estate both in the UK and overseas, we are looking for an additional Acoustics Design Manager to be fully accountable for the development, evolution and ownership of acoustic specifications across each of PureGym's formats. You will also lead the design of acoustic solutions for non-standard developments.

The scope of your role will be PureGym's rapidly growing UK estate of c.300 gyms, as well as our expanding operation in Switzerland, Denmark, and North America. There will also be opportunity to work with our wider international estate and franchise operation, most recently being Saudi Arabia, further down the line.

THE PERSON

Your role will either align to the London or Leeds head offices (c.one day in the office per week), and the rest of the time you will work from home and be out on site at gyms across the UK as per project requirements.

On a day-to-day basis, your role will involve the following:

- Support and inform feasibility assessments through acoustic risk reviews and profiling of new and existing PureGym properties.
- Instruct appropriate, site-specific acoustic surveys via a framework of external acoustic consultants.
- Review acoustic consultants' recommendations and designs for both compliance with PureGym specifications, best value and fit.
- Manage framework consultants and key product suppliers ensuring services and materials delivered reflect service level agreements.
- Monitor, periodically review and rank the performance of framework consultants and key material suppliers. Support robust procurement processes including managing and renewing existing agreements, selecting alternative and additional suppliers.
- Project manage the design process for bespoke and novel acoustic solutions for challenging and non-standard and gym developments, working alongside in-house and external designers.
- Balance risk, cost, and time considerations to make informed commercial recommendations to peers and the wider business on acoustic design, including opportunities to limit/exclude mitigation.
- Input in to cost management of acoustic solutions and requirements including creating and updating mitigation case studies.
- Continuously research and develop improved noise mitigation solutions and optionality into the development process.
- Investigate, advise, and report on noise/vibration complaints affecting existing PureGym properties engaging with various internal and external stakeholders.

- Support, inform, challenge and influence when necessary senior level stakeholders and other teams within PureGym.
- This is a key role in our growing Property Development team, and will suit someone with strong project management skills, experienced dealing with acoustics in a property development setting.
- You will bring strong, clear understanding of acoustic risks, requirements and solutions, contributing to fast-paced multi-site property developments on a large scale, as well as multiple third-party stakeholders.
- Qualifications-wise, you will have been educated to degree level and ideally be a member of IOA or similar. Understanding technical drawings and plans will be key so that you can input into and amend as necessary.
- We are a fast-paced business and so being able to resolve difficult situations and make critical decisions under pressure is key.
- You will work with a variety of colleagues within PureGym, including influencing at a senior level, so strong communication and relationship-building skills are key. The Property Development team has a culture of high performance with a laser-like focus on delivery, underpinned with lots of support and encouragement from others in the team and throughout PureGym.
- Finally, you will be a commercially astute, effective negotiator, able to balance gym member and brand expectations with return on investment in your decision making.
