

Sound Insulation Testing Auditor

Leeds/Manchester/Sheffield & Remote Working - £33k pa

Job Description

Your responsibilities will include conducting auditing on sound insulation testers within the SITMA Certification Scheme, in line with its forthcoming UKAS Accreditation requirements. You would also be responsible for signing and countersigning audit reports, providing support, and potentially delivering training in the areas of air, sound, and ventilation. Additionally, you may conduct remote audits of airtightness testers using the ATTMA Lodgement Portal Tools, function as an examination invigilator, and mark examinations once conducted.

Experience

You should be experienced in the area of sound insulation testing, ideally having conducted hundreds, if not thousands of sound insulation tests across a variety of projects. Similarly, expertise in air tightness testing would be beneficial, but not mandatory. You should possess a strong knowledge of BS EN ISO 140-4, BS EN ISO 140-7, and good knowledge of ISO 717-1 and ISO 717-2. Knowledge of ATTMA TSL1, ATTMA TSL2, ISO 9972, and CIBSE TM23 would be beneficial. Attention to detail, precision, and the ability to work independently or as part of a team are essential qualities for this role.

Holding the IOA Diploma in Acoustics & Noise Control would be beneficial. The role is based in and around the Leeds office, but could be Manchester or Sheffield with the right candidate, with at least one day per week at home or in the office and the rest generally remote. While demanding, the position is also enjoyable, positioning you as an industry professional supporting member, auditing, and ensuring the integrity of the certification scheme.

Training will be provided for candidates, but some experience is necessary for consideration for an interview. The job is full-time, offering a salary of £33,000 per year, along with benefits such as a company car, company pension and flexitime working. The schedule is Monday to Friday, and reliable commuting to Leeds is required. Applicants should also be in possession of a valid UK driving license with three or fewer penalty points and have the right to work in the United Kingdom.
